After his pension came Mr. Journey asked payment but Shaw refused and was seen at his house; both he and his wife, being under influence of liquor.

I do not write in the expectation of ever getting the money which he promised the association, but that you may know how deceitful and unreliable the man has proved to be -

And said applicant further stipulates and agrees that he will abide by and obey all the rules and regulations made by the Board of Trustees, or by their order; that he will perform all duties required of him and obey all lawful orders of the Officers of the Home.
